

Titus 2 Ministry FAQ

1. Why is this women's discipleship ministry called "Titus 2"?

The Titus 2 mandate was given to the young pastor Titus, by Paul, in Titus 2:1-5. He instructed Titus to equip older women in the congregation to teach the younger women.

2. What is the purpose of this ministry?

The purpose is to encourage and equip intergenerational women to glorify God by learning to establish covenant relationships with one another, apply biblical principles to friendships and circumstances, and think biblically about womanhood.

3. What is the curriculum?

This year we will be using: Adorned- Living Out the Beauty of the Gospel Together by Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth

4. Is there homework?

Participants are encouraged to read the assigned chapter(s) and be prepared to discuss it. Even if you aren't able to prepare, we want you to be with your group and participate.

5. What will we do at the meetings?

In addition to discussing the assigned chapter(s), we will spend time getting to know one another, sharing prayer requests, and praying for one another. Plus, we will have a few social times for fun!

6. How long is the commitment if I join a group?

This is a one-year discipleship cycle. The "Heart-to-Heart" Kick-off Tea is on Sunday, September 22nd, at 2:00pm.

Your group will meet once a month for approximately two hours. We will meet in October, November, December (social/fun gathering), January, February, March, April, and wrap up in May. (This is only 8 meetings)

7. Is this ministry just for young mothers?

No... it is for single and married women; college students and working professionals; mothers, empty nesters, and grandmothers.

This is an intergenerational ministry for women ages 18-118, and all are invited to participate.

8. Why is it called "spiritual mothering?"

Because T2D is a nurturing ministry

9. How many women are in each group?

There will be 6 to 8 women in each group.

10. Are women grouped by age or interest?

Neither! You sign up for a time and location that is most convenient for you. We hope there will be diversity of ages, interests, spiritual maturity, and experiences in each group. We are all sisters in Christ and the experience will be richer if we have the opportunity to get to know women in a variety of life-seasons and circumstances.

11. When and where will the groups meet?

1. First Monday (morning), 10:00am-12:00pm in the church parlor – childcare available
2. First Monday (evening) 6:30-8:30 pm, Tuscany Trace neighborhood, South College Station, TX
3. Fourth Tuesday (evening), 6:30pm – 8:30pm Stone Forest neighborhood-Pebble Creek area/South College Station, TX
4. Second Thursday (evening), 6:00pm – 8:00pm Castlegate neighborhood in South College Station, TX.
5. First Saturday (morning) 10:00-11:30am, Oaks neighborhood, Bryan (near the church)
6. Saturday Morning, 10:00am-11:45am in the Tiffany Park neighborhood in Bryan, TX. The Saturdays will work around TAMU Football games. The dates will be shared at the kick-off tea.
